

AZED PRO RECERTIFICATION

Recertification of your AZED Pro is done by obtaining a certain number of points over a 3-year cycle. Points are awarded on activities that give back to the profession. Higher points are given for major events, such as conferences and classes, while other points are awarded for activities such as speaking at an IEDC event, publishing a news article, grading tests, participation in webinars, and other activities. The point system is outlined below.

To complete your AZED Pro recertification, you must acquire 11 points over 3 years. You must have points from each category.

LEVEL 1 POINTS (3 POINTS EACH; MAX OF 6 POINTS)

- Panelist on AZED Pro seminar/webinar
- Presenter at Conference
- Serve on AAED Board
- Chair or Vice Chair an AAED Committee or Affinity Group
- Serve as a mentor for Young Professionals
- Recruit new AZED Pro candidates
- Writing a white paper for AAED

LEVEL 2 POINTS (2 POINTS EACH EVENT; MAX OF 6 POINTS)

- Attend Spring Conference
- Attend Fall Forum
- Writing a news article for AAED
- Securing sponsorship for AAED events

LEVEL 3 POINTS (1 POINT EACH; MAX OF 3 POINTS)

- Attend a webinar
- Attend an after-hours AAED special event
- Serve on an AAED committee or Affinity Group

AZED Pros need to keep track of their own points and submit documentation, via the AAED Recertification Form, for recertification every three years, and pay the \$50.00 recertification fee. Applications can be accepted once annually.
